This week we are featuring the **Animal Control By-law** (By-law 14-21, with amendments) which contains information regarding **licencing and registration**, **limitations on the number of pets, animals at large and nuisance** within Mississippi Mills.

Quick facts:

- All dogs must be registered and tagged. Dog tags can be purchased at the Municipal Office and are valid for 1 year (expire on December 31st each year).
- Number of dogs permitted:
 - Almonte and surrounding Hamlets no more than three (3) dogs.
 - Outside of Almonte and surrounding Hamlets no more than six (6) dogs.
 - Hunters may have no more than twelve (12) dogs.
- A dog or other animal shall be deemed to be running at large unless the dog or other animal is on the owner's property or is:
 - a) constrained by a leash, and
 - b) under the direct control of the owner or owner's designate, or
 - c) indoors, or
 - d) contained within a vehicle or cage, or
 - e) fenced in on the owner(s)' property, or
 - f) dogs are permitted to run at large in an area that is securely enclosed and
 - g) specifically designated as a dog park by the Municipality.
- Be sure to pick up after your dog. The By-law requires that dog waste be removed from public property and be disposed of appropriately e.g. flush down the toilet.
