The purpose of this memorandum is to summarize the future development servicing associated with Official Plan Amendment No. 22 that remains consistent with the Municipality's updated Water and Wastewater Master Servicing Plan.

The updated Water and Wastewater Master Servicing Plan (JLR, 2018) was presented to Council on December 18, 2018 that accounted for growth over the next 20 years and beyond to future build areas (refer to attached for the complete Master Servicing Plan). The future build areas included in the Master Servicing Plan remain consistent with urban boundary expansions considered as part of OPA 22. Anticipated servicing requirements for each area identified in OPA 22 are summarized as follows:

## Area 1

- Included in Master Plan build-out future development areas.
- Water servicing requires watermain upgrades and extensions of municipal services through infill area to the south (Envoy Lands) along with trunk watermain upgrades along Martin Street and Carss Street. Water servicing will benefit from Third River crossing proposed for future development in the north west area of Almonte and future development along Mississippi River, along with Patterson Street watermain extension.
- Wastewater servicing anticipates sewer outlet to Victoria Street trunk sewer at future Menzie Street extension.
- Stormwater: Unknown but anticipated that local water quality and quantity can be managed on site and outlet to near existing Mill Run SWM facility.

## Area 2

- Included in Master Plan build-out future development areas.
- Water servicing, additional watermain extension along Appleton Side Road, in addition to future commercial development south of the industrial park.
- Wastewater pumping station and forcemain required to connect proposed development to gravity sewer system
  near Patterson Street and Houston Street. Requires industrial park sewer be routed along Houston Street, under
  Ottawa Street to the new Victoria Street trunk sewer. These sewer upgrades are required to prevent future sewer
  surcharging of the existing Ottawa Street sanitary sewer.
- Stormwater: Unknown but anticipate that local water quality and quantity can be managed on site. Outlet location and depth remain unknown and could impact development potential.

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## Area 3A

- Included in Master Plan build-out future development areas.
- Water Servicing requires a separate River crossing through the widest part of the Mississippi River, along with trunk water servicing extension along County Road 29.
- Wastewater Servicing likely via gravity sewer extension from County Drive.
- Sanitary sewer upgrades are anticipated along County Drive to accommodate the proposed development.
- Stormwater: Unknown but anticipated that local water quality and quantity can be managed on-site and outlet to the Mississippi River.
