A BY - LAW to designate the building known municipaly as
"The Banning Home" situated on Part of Lot 22, Concession 2,
more particularly described in instrument number 37108,
Village of Clayton, Township of Ramsay as being of architectural
and historical value or interest.

WHEREAS The Ontario Heritage Foundation Act, R S O 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by — laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon to be of architectural value or interest: and WHEREAS the council of the Corporation of the Township of Ramsay has caused to be served on the ownersaof the lands and premises known as "The Banning Home" situated on Part of lot 22, Concession 2, More particularly described in instrument number 37108 Village of Clayton, Township of Ramsay, and upon The Ortario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and have caused such notice of intention to so designate, to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality, once for each of three consecutive weeks: and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality,

THEREFORE the Council of the Componation of the Township of Ramsay enacts as follows:

- 1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest, the real property known as "The Banning Home" situated on Part of Lot 22, Concession 2, Village of Clayton, more particularly described in instrument number 37108, Township of Ramsay.
- 2. The municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by law to be registered against the property, described, in the proper Land Registry Office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by law to be served on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality, once a week for three consecutive weeks.
