Annually, Council will choose one recipient from this award pool to put forward for the Ontario Senior of the Year Award.



This award celebrates individuals who have gone the extra mile, inspirational leaders in local business who set an example finding ways to adapt and lead past survival to prosperity.

These individuals have made a lasting impact beyond their own business needs, contributing to the promotion and success of the greater Mississippi Mills business community.



This award recognizes individuals who exemplify excellence leading initiatives that help to shape Mississippi Mills into a welcoming community for newcomers and in particular that foster an understanding and sharing of other cultures.

The impact of these nominees may have helped to build intercultural trust, tackled racism or reduced barriers for marginalized communities.



The purpose of this award is to recognize local residents or honour esteemed visitors that have made a unique contribution to the Municipality of Mississippi Mills and beyond. Recipients are recognized broadly for their contributions or have served in an exceptional capacity.

Examples of this award could be a resident who has been recognized with the Order of Canada, represented Canada at the Olympics or a visiting celebrity.



This award celebrates the contributions residents have made through volunteering. Volunteers contribute to the vibrancy, diversity and strength of our community.

This award will be presented annually to exceptional volunteers whose contributions have made a significant impact within Mississippi Mills. Only contributions made through volunteerism will be recognized, but can be related to an individual's expertise from training, work experience or education.



This award celebrates the extraordinary accomplishments of Mississippi Mills youth (aged 12–21) who are helping to make our community and the world a better place.

Recipients may inspire and motivate others, demonstrate outstanding initiative, or have overcome tremendous adversity.
